UNITS OF COMPETENCY

CHCAOD001 - Work in an alcohol and other drugs context

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to establish and work within the current context, philosophy and values of the alcohol and other drugs sector.

CHCAOD006 - Provide interventions for people with alcohol and other drugs issues

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to confirm, conduct and monitor intervention strategies to address alcohol and other drugs issues.

CHCAOD004 - Assess needs of clients with alcohol and other drugs issues

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to prepare for and conduct assessments of alcohol and other drugs clients to determine eligibility, service requirements and referral needs.

CHCAOD009 - Develop and review individual alcohol and other drugs treatment plans

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to work collaboratively with clients to establish treatment goals, and develop and evaluate individual treatment plans to meet those goals.
